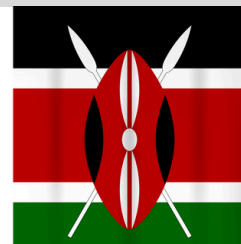

### **Mufasa Movie Fieldtrip**
