WELCOME! Psalm 95 is a call to praise the Lord. So welcome, friends. Let us enter with praise to the LORD and acknowledge with humility and obedient hearts the Lord's kingship over His people!

NOTE: As our bell rings five minutes prior to our service, we gather in preparation for worship.

SACRAMENT: In Holy Communion we recognize Christ's true body and blood given to us for the forgiveness of sins. Paul writes in 1 Corinthians 11: 27-29, "Let a person examine himself and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup." Therefore, we reflect on the following questions to prepare us for the Lord's Supper:

1. Do I believe that I am a sinful human being? (Matt. 26:28; Col. 2:13)
2. Am I sorry for my sins? (Ps. 38:18; 2 Cor. 7:9-10)
3. Do I believe Jesus died and rose again for my sins? (1 Cor. 15:3-4)
4. Do I intend, by the power of the Holy Spirit, to live a godly life? (Eph. 4: 1-3)
5. Do I believe Jesus' body and blood are received with the bread and wine in Holy Communion? (Matt. 26: 26-28; 1 Cor. 10:16, 11:27)
