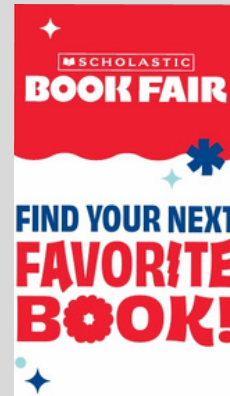


## Trinity and Scholastic Books
