Here at Trinity we follow the SRP (Standard Response Protocol) safety program. Principal Ibarra explained this program during chapel at the beginning of the year and to-date we have had a fire safety drill and lock down drill.

We practice these safety protocols on a regular basis to ensure the students and staff are prepared in cases of emergency.

As part of our school safety, parents door fobs have limited access of 7:45-8:15 and and Enrichment fobs work 8:45-9:15 and 12:00-1:00. The limited access helps keep the school locked down and secure. If you need access at other times please ring the bell. You will need to identify yourself before being allowed in.
